- Reviewed the purposes of observational tools
- Considered the role of feedback in learning and assessment
- Discussed ways to develop trainee participation in a range of appropriate activities
- Reviewed the role of MSF in surgical training
- Set goals for future practice with the trainee
- Considered ways to allow trainees access to learning opportunities in the workplace
- Identified common conversations with trainees
- Discussed ways to ensure effective use of WBAs to develop learning
- Highlighted ways to ensure trainees are observed and receive feedback
- Shared examples of supervisory practice
- Begun to record their supervisory practice
